

Lindfield Village Hub Reference Committee

Expression of Interest 13-2018

Lindfield Village Hub is an ambitious urban renewal project proposed by Ku-ring-gai Council to revitalise Lindfield town centre. When completed, the Village Hub – located on the western edge of Lindfield - will transform this area into an attractive, vibrant and dynamic urban village. The project will deliver a carefully planned mix of community buildings, public open spaces, new homes, alongside new dining and retail experiences. Council has resolved to convene a Reference Committee for the Lindfield Village Hub development.

Role of the Committee

To provide advice to Council on community related development outcomes limited to the following areas:

- Communication and engagement
- Place making
- Environmental sustainability
- Planning and design outcomes
- Service delivery
- Social procurement

Note the Reference Committee will not deliberate on any matters considered as commercial in confidence; which includes but is not limited to financial and economic viability, tender and procurement methodology or evaluation matters.

Membership

The Committee's Membership will comprise:

- Mayor (chairperson) and 3 Councillors
- 5 community representatives
- 1 representative from Transport for NSW and
- 1 representative from Roads & Maritime Services

Council advertised for 5 volunteer community representatives who can contribute to the outcomes listed above.
