Australian Blind Football is an initiative of Blind Sports Australia and is the recognised pathway of Football Federation Australia (FFA) for people who are blind or vision impaired to play football. Australian Blind Football works to provide a pathway to compete on the international stage, while also supporting grassroots organisations from across the country to provide blind football opportunities to people who are blind or vision impaired.
