Wendy Matthews has an expressive voice that never fails to move those who hear it. Leaving Canada at 16, she hitchhiked to LA where she worked for seven years, eventually connecting with Glenn Shorrock, who brought her back to oz for Little River Bands 1983 tour, and she's been here ever since. In demand as a back up vocalist, she went on to join iconic bands the Models and Absent Friends before kicking off a solo career, which featured multiple top 20 releases. She has been recognized with over a dozen industry awards and is an Australian singing icon.

Wendy continues to perform and record across a diverse range of styles from jazz to blues, from rock to gospel, from soul to pop and of course, there are the beautiful ballads. Today she resides on her 10 acre property in the hinterland of the mid-North Coast, where she also runs a jewellery business creating silver jewellery in the Navajo style.

Come party at Sydney's historic Paddington Town Hall

Built in the late 1800s the impressive Paddington Town Hall sits at the highest point on the Oxford Street ridge. Next to the Victoria Barracks the Town Hall has a 32m high clock tower, which was completed in 1905 to commemorate the coronation of Edward VII, dominating the Paddington skyline. Paddington Town Hall is less than 5km from Sydney's CBD and a magnificent setting for this year's Glam and Grunge.

Why we fundraise?

StreetWork is mostly reliant on grant funding and donations from individual and corporate donors as well as church and community groups, in order to operate. We **do not** receive any recurrent government funding for the services we provide to 'at risk' young people.

Our annual operating costs are approximately \$350,000 per branch and over 92% of all donations are used to deliver services which directly benefit 'at risk' YP. However this income is insufficient to meet the growing demand for our services, so StreetWork runs a number of fundraising events each year to ensure we generate the income required. StreetWork maintains best practice in the not-for-profit sector with administration costs kept to the very lowest levels, enabling the organisation to deliver a high social return on investment and ensure its sustainability.

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
