Land Status – Barra Brui Sportground, St Ives

Lands Advisory Services (Landsas) has investigated the land status of Reserves 88943 and 86634 Barra Brui Sportground, St Ives, provided by email 10 May 2019.

The attached investigation considers:

- if Native Title is likely to have been extinguished based on a Previous Exclusive Possession Act under Section 23B of the *Native Title Act 1993*.
- the validity of R88493 and R86634 as an earlier act for the purpose of section 24JA of the *Native Title Act 1993*.

In my opinion the grant of Special Lease 31-95 Metropolitan to John Boyne Degotardi and the grant of Special Lease 42.22 Metropolitan to Gordon John Bright may be consistent with Section 23B(2)(c)(i) and Schedule 1 Part 1 (3)(8) of the *Native Title Act 1993* and is likely to have extinguished native title over part of the reserves.

Note that only the Federal court of Australia may determine whether native title has been extinguished.

Reserves 88493 and 86634 – Barra Brui Sportground and Community Centre

Land Status

The Land is identified as Lot 7318 in Deposited Plan (DP) 1158573 (See **Tag A**) and Lot 825 in DP 752031.

The Land is held by the State of New South Wales in the first schedule (see **Tag B**). This Crown land is listed in Table 1 showing the purpose for which the land is reserved, evidence of the reservation and the legislative power (section and Act name) used to reserve the land.

The Land was subject to earlier reservations which are not relevant to the purposes of this status investigation.

Native Title

There is no current Native Title Claim affecting the Land.

That part of Lot 7318 and Lot 825 which was previously part of Portion 572 in the Parish of Gordon (see **Tag F**) was subject to Special Lease 31-95 Metropolitan for the purpose of grazing and agriculture issued to John Boyne Degotardi, commencing 1 May 1932 (see **Tag G**), under the *Crown Lands Consolidation Act 1913*.

The grant of Special Lease 31-95 Metropolitan to John Boyne Degotardi may be consistent with Section 23B(2)(c)(i) and Schedule 1 Part 1 (3)(8) of the *Native Title Act 1993*¹.

Part Lot 825 (including part R.86634) was formerly part of Special Lease 42.22 Metropolitan for Vegetable and nursery garden granted to Gordon John Bright commencing 1 October 1942 over portions 617 and 618 in the Parish of Gordon (see **Tag H**). Please see **Tag I** for Crown Plans showing the relationship between the existing lots and portions 617 and 618.

The Grant of Special Lease 42.22 Metropolitan may be consistent with Section 23B(2)(c)(i) and Schedule 1(3)(8) of the *Native Title Act 1993*.

In my opinion Native Title is likely to have been extinguished for the land subject to these special leases².

¹ Note: Schedule 1 of the NTA refers to *agriculture (or any similar purpose) and grazing combined* as a scheduled interest under Part 1(3)(8). Special lease 31-95 Metropolitan was issued for the purpose of *grazing and agriculture*. NTSCorp Limited have expressed opinion that this type of variation may indicate native title was not extinguished under this Schedule. I am not aware of this having been tested in Court but note that Courts have held that variation of wording is permitted in some cases.

² Note: only the Federal Court of Australia makes a determination in relation to the existence of Native Title

The area within Lots 7318 and 825, subject to Special Leases 31-95 Metropolitan (pink) and Special Lease 42.22 Metropolitan (blue)³, is shown in Figure 1.

Other later acts may have been further extinguishing acts over these sections.

I have found no other administrative acts on the residual of Lot 7318 and 825 which are likely to have extinguished native title. Please note that I have not investigated the potential of public works to have extinguished native title.

Crown Land Management Act 2016

1. Ku-ring-gai Council was appointed Reserve Trust manager of R.88493 under section 95 of the *Crown Lands Act 1989* on 12 May 2006 (see **Tag J**).

The Council of the Municipality of Ku-ring-gai was appointed as trustee of R.86634 under the *Public Trusts Act 1897* on 19 April 1968 (see **Tag K**).

2. A search of the National Native Title Tribunal Registers on 14 May 2019 indicates:
 - a. There is no current a native title application (claim) over the subject land.
 - b. No determination of native title has yet been made, and
 - c. no Indigenous Land Use Agreement has been registered affecting R.88493 or R.86634.
3. We are not aware of any compulsory acquisitions of native title or future act protection determinations which would impact the R.88493 or R.86634.
4. We are not aware of the any native title certificates under the *Crown Land Management Act 2016* (CLMA) having been issued.
5. For the purposes of Section 8.7(1) of the CLMA:
 - a. R.88493 and R.86634 is *relevant land*,
 - b. none of R.88493 or R.86634 is *excluded land*.
 - c. Ku-ring-gai Council is the *Responsible Person*








